May 13-23, 2019

The International Lyceum Club of Stockholm is pleased to welcome members of the Lyceum clubs worldwide and the persons accompanying them to participate in the 34th Congress of the IALC in Stockholm.

The Congress (May 17-19) will take place at the Clarion Sign Hotel, where we have reserved standard rooms (May 12-13 and 15-20) at the negotiated price 1595 SEK/night and room, i.e. same price for single or double use. Breakfast buffet is included.

A guided tour in the Old town will be organised for the accompanying persons when the International Council meets.

The event begins with the pre-tour to Dalarna (Dalecarlia), north-west of Stockholm, the most Swedish and romantic of our counties (May 13-15).

The post-tour (May 20-23) goes to Gotland in the middle of the Baltic Sea, appr. 90 km from the Swedish mainland. The island is beautiful and peaceful with a unique light, which inspired film director Ingmar Bergman to build his home and studio here. The medieval town of Visby gained World Heritage status in 1995.
